



## TOURNAMENT RULES & INFORMATION

### 19<sup>th</sup> Annual “Golf Gets In Your Blood” Scramble

Monday, October 3, 2011

#### East Lake Woodlands

| <b>FORMAT</b>    | <b>Four Person Scramble</b> - Everyone hits from the selected shot.  |
| <b>RULES</b>     | Move all four (4) balls no more than one (1) club length from the original position <b>no nearer the hole</b> . On the green, no more than 6 inches. The ball must not change conditions, i.e. from rough to fairway, fringe to green, etc.  |
| <b>HANDICAP</b>  | Net Team Scores to be determined by East Lake Woodland’s Handicap Formula  |
| <b>TEES</b>      | Men play the WHITE tees. Women play the RED tees.  |
| <b>BOGEY MAX</b> | The maximum score on any hole is a bogey. The Bogey Max Rule applies as follows: if your group is at PAR and has not holed out, we ask that you <b>pick up your ball and proceed to the next tee box and take bogey as your score</b> . This is to ensure your pace of play for the day. |
| <b>TIES</b>      | If there is a tie for any position, a match of cards will be used to determine winners starting at the number 1 handicap hole.   |
| <b>RAIN</b>      | Players will be notified if play is suspended. If nine holes are completed by everyone, the tournament will be based upon total number of holes played by all.   |

*Each team is eligible for only one team prize. Each individual is eligible for only one Closest to the Pin or Longest Drive prize. Final authority for the distribution of prizes and awards are at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.*

**PRO STATUS** - No foursome that includes a pro golfer may be eligible for prizes for low foursome scores. In addition, no professional golfers are eligible for prizes on any contest holes.

**MULLIGANS** – (1) mulligan allowed per player per Premium Super Pak purchase. Mulligan may not be used on any contest hole including a Par 3 Hole In One.

**\$10,000 50’ Putt and Hole-in-One** – Current and former Pro Golfers and Pro Athletes are ineligible for the HIO contests or the \$10,000 50’ Putt Challenge.
